2016 -2017*

During 2016 and 2017, the Bread of Life (BOL) mission project, supported by WHFMS and mission programs within our Advent Christian churches, supplemented outreach feeding programs in nine countries. These programs include Christ-centered lessons and activities that focus on orphans and children of low income families.

Not only have Bread of Life contributions helped meet physical needs, they have also given our ministry leaders an opportunity to provide a meal or snack and to reach out and share the Word of God with others. This project has made a difference in giving many the opportunity to experience God's love and to come to know our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Below are two of the responses from our mission fields:

THAILAND **Christian Mission ban Naratchakwai**

This feeding program helps children who have problems in their lives. This year's funding helped Chiraphon Nontasri, a girl with heart disease. She has received treatment for five years and is improving. She has to see the doctor every year. Christian Mission was able to cover her fare and hotel. Her life has been made better. She lives with her family and receives the same opportunities to study as other children.

Another woman that the BOL has helped is Dtaa. Her Thai name is Wiyanan Laerpon. Christian Mission paid for her semester fees for the last payment for graduation. Sadly, her mom was killed in an accident while coming back from her commencement day. Dtaa cares for her father, who was injured in the accident.

INDIA **Yesuway Jeevan Mission Ministry Partner** **Pastor Pani**

Pastor Pani in Odisha continues his ministries to the unreached tribal peoples in his state. He reported in March 2017 that his Odisha missions had started a Bible study course. They are conducting this Bible class to equip all

believers in their mission fields to grow in their faith in God. They are also giving educational tuition classes to Sunday school children in the village ministries.

World Outreach sent funds from the Bread of Life program to Pastor Ahaj Kumar Pani in Odisha. On May 14, 2017, he held a feeding program for needy people from the Brajarajnagar mission field.

In early July 2017, he reported that they are preaching the good news of our Lord Jesus Christ to these poor people. He distributed New Testaments and gospel tracts to village people. Many of them heard the gospel for the first time.

Pastor Pani reports that the urban mission field in the Kandhamal District has grown to over 200. He now has six mission fields.
