Table Top Family Devotional Guide


Instructions:

JESUS IS THE WAY



Consider giving your child the opportunity to earn \$2. Then go to the grocery store together to see how much you can buy for \$2. Use this opportunity to discuss "wants" vs. "needs." Consider donating your \$2 of food (or more!) to your local food pantry.

AT HOME

Half of the people in Malawi live in poverty (undp.org). Living in poverty means there is not enough money for necessities like food, shelter and clothing. Can you imagine living on \$2 or less a day? \$2 a day may seem like a lot of money to a kid. However, it takes much more than that to pay for shelter, fuel, medicine, transportation and food.

MONEY

Most people in Malawi speak either English or Chichewa. "Hello" in Chichewa is "Moni" (moni)! "Thank you" in Chichewa is "Zikomo" (zee-ko-mo)! Have fun saying "Moni" and "Zikomo" today.

MEMORIZE

"Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'" – John 14:6

READ

Jesus made it clear that he is the only way to be saved from sin and have eternal life. One religious group, Muslims, do not believe that Jesus is the way. Some Muslims in Malawi are paying people money to turn away from the truth of the Bible. They offer to pay for children to go to school and then teach them about Islam. Because many people are without food and provision, it is hard for them to say "no."

PRAY

- ▶ Thank God for the faithful pastors and churches in Malawi that teach Jesus as the way.
- ▶ Pray that God would strengthen his people when temptation comes.
- ▶ Pray that Christians in Malawi would encourage one another when facing difficulty.
