## Table Top Family Devotional Guide


### Instructions:

## JESUS IS THE VINE



Have you ever seen a rotten grape? Why do some grapes get wrinkled and squishy? (They fall off the vine and they die). Why do grapes need a vine to grow? (Grapes grow because they are connected to the vine. They vine supplies water and nutrients to the grape). Just like grapes have to be connected to the vine to grow, we must be connected to Jesus to be fruitful.
