BUILDING HEALTHY LEADERSHIP WITH THE

PHILIPPINE ADVENT CHRISTIAN CONFERENCE'S VISION 20/20

The Philippine Advent Christian Conference (PACCI) for the past two years has stressed the theme, "Building Healthy Leadership aiming towards PACCI Vision 20/20." It is our vision to see 20,000

disciples in the year 2020. To ensure the vision's fulfillment, we adopted a system called "Intensified Cell Group Strategy." We envision an intensive cell or small group ministry in every local church, making them the avenue toward building each member into a leader. To help us obtain our goal for this vision, we are working to build healthier leadership. This will stand for the next coming years, because we know establishing quality leaders is essential to the ministry.

Leadership influences the success or failure of any organization. It is revealed in history that when God's people had a good king, all was well. In contrast, when they had a bad king, everyone went to poverty. The time surely is coming that the Lord Jesus will come as a judge, who won't just separate the sheep from the goats, but will also prove how faithful we are as his servants pertaining to the task entrusted to us. PACCI has pledged to contribute to the fulfilment of God's vision to make all people groups of the world followers of

the Lord Jesus. As a conference body, accomplishing our share in the Great Commission requires strong and healthy leadership.

Trainings, particularly on disciple-making, are conducted in districts down to the local church level, with a goal of aiming to raise 500 cell group leaders during a two-year period. As of now, there are 267 volunteers/cell group leaders (including assistant leaders) working alongside their pastors in making disciples through small groups. This record is based upon responses from those who attended the trainings and pledged to engage in discipleship.

During the 8th Biennial meeting, the report indicated 4,799 as total membership. As of February, 2017, the tally rose to 5,268, denoting a 9% growth rate. Twenty-nine organized churches in 2014 now reaches to 32, while our outreach churches grew by 10, with 42 in 2014 to a present count of 52. Subsequent to the membership growth, a notable increase in our monetary receipts and balances has been seen. This year has dawned with over 300,000 pesos (\$6,000 US).

God has allowed me to see my six years of overseeing the conference as an avenue and a





period for further learning. I have failed in some instances, but I sensed failure as an integral part of the learning experience. In fact, it is in experiencing failure that finally led me to aim for excellence.

In my meditations, the Lord has led me to his words calling us to be his body. We are of many parts of which he is the head. The body cannot become whole if one or even a part of it is absent. So for it to accomplish much, there has to be complementation of each part. God provided us the means where we need to fix our meditation. From him, who is the head, the whole body grows and builds itself up when it is joined and held together by every supporting ligament and as each part does its work. Surely, God has great things for us to accomplish during our time and we need to work together as one body to complete his work.
