Ambassador Trip to Nsanje, Malawi

Trip Date: June 26 - July 4, 2023

Purpose: To provide local church leaders with a guided first-hand experience of an Advent Christian mission field.

Why Go?

- Personally get to know ministry leaders from our AC churches in Malawi and Mozambique.
- Get a first-hand taste of the culture and setting of our ministries in Malawi and Mozambique.
- Experience the Lord working through worship and evangelism in a different culture.
- Provide encouragement and fellowship for our ministry leaders in Malawi and Mozambique.
- Get to know mission advocates from other AC churches as you travel together.

Activities

- Engage with pastors and ministry leaders from Malawi and Mozambique during a 3-4 day ministry conference. *The conference will include teaching sessions, fellowship times, and meals.*
- Share your testimony during an open-air evangelism event.
- Participate in worship in a local Malawian AC church.
- Help host a soccer match between ministry leaders from Malawi and Mozambique.

Cost

- \$2,700 per person
- To be submitted to ACGC by March 30 *Includes airfare, hotel, meals, visa, travel insurance, pastors' conference sponsorship and administration fee. This does not include costs for passports, travel immunizations, and personal spending money.*

Vaccination Requirement

COVID-19 proof of vaccination is required for entry into Malawi.

Ambassador Process

- 1. Submit the Interest Form from our ambassador web page at https://www.acgc.us/ambassador/#Interest
- 2. A trip coordinator will contact you.
- 3. We will send you ACGC's Short Term Missions Trip Policy and ACGC's Trip Participant Code of Conduct. The Short Term Missions Trip Policy needs to be read and understood.

 The Trip Participant Code of Conduct needs to be signed and returned to ACGC.
- 4. If you will be raising funds for your trip, a trip coordinator will provide you with guidelines.
- 5. \$2,700 must be submitted to ACGC by March 30, 2023. After March 30, a trip coordinator will facilitate the purchase of visas for the group and purchase airfare and travel insurance for all group members.
- 6. In the weeks prior to the trip, a trip coordinator will hold Zoom meetings for prayer and other trip preparation matters. *Attendance at these meetings is mandatory.*
