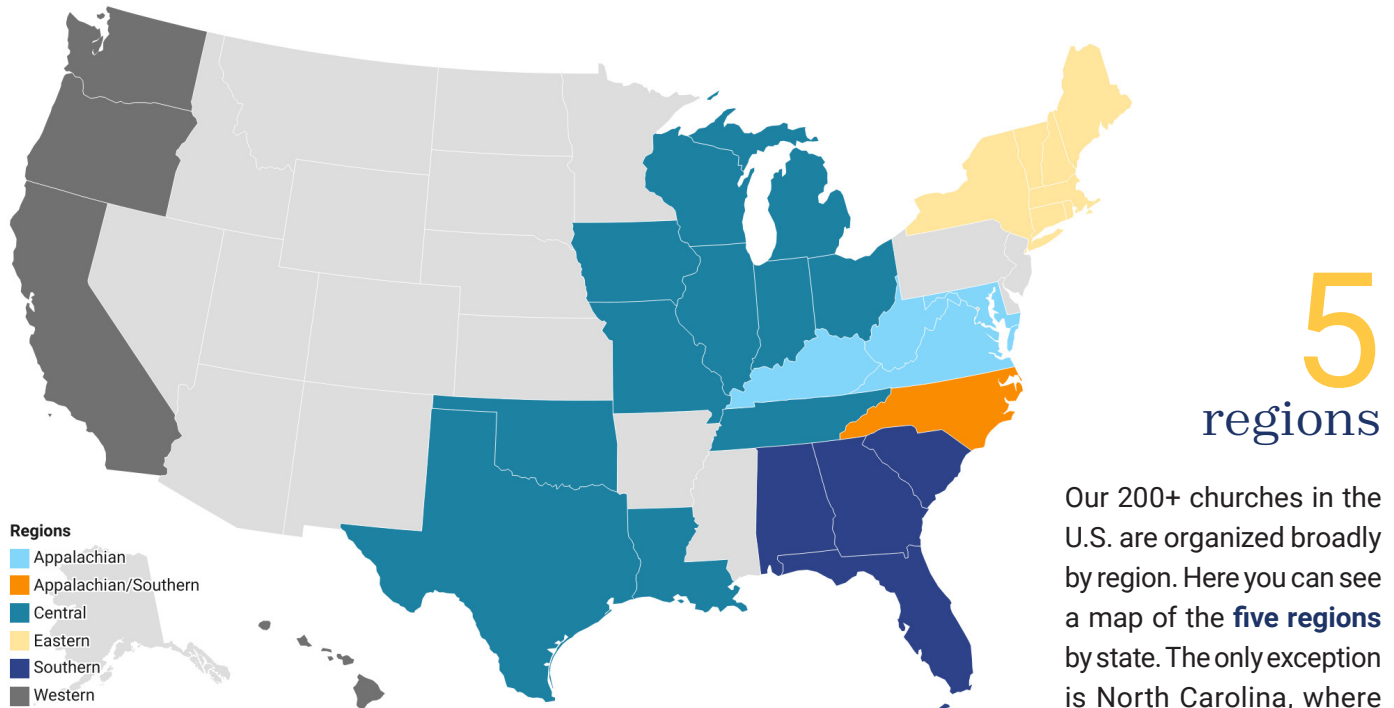
Mission and Structure

Our Mission

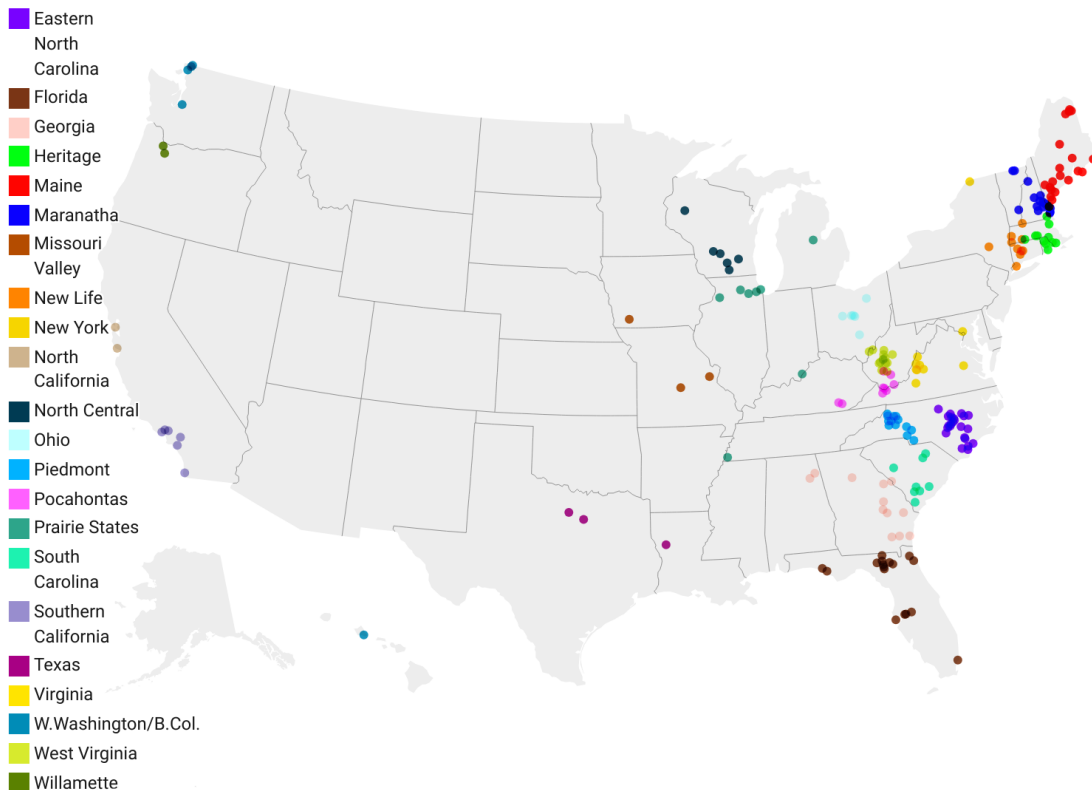

Our 200+ churches in the U.S. are organized broadly by region. Here you can see a map of the **five regions** by state. The only exception is North Carolina, where the east side of N.C. falls in the Southern Region and the west side is part of the Appalachian Region.

23 conferences

Conferences are networks of churches in limited geographical areas that are subsets of the regions. While the **twenty-three conferences** vary in size and function, most credential pastors, pool resources for local ministry and provide opportunities for fellowship among churches on the local level.
